

The beauties of the Gulf of Naples

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The Gulf of Naples is truly an incredible scenic and enchanting place, a semicircular inlet of the Tyrrhenian Sea (an arm of the Mediterranean Sea) southwest of the city of Naples. It is 10 miles wide (16km) and extends southeastwards for 20 miles (32km.) The city of Naples is the major port and is a real treasure trove of art. Its historic centre which encompasses 2,500 years of indelible signs of past dominations, has been awarded pretigious World Heritage status by UNESCO.





There are many coastal towns in the Gulf. Sorrento is the main town on the coast of the Sorrento Peninsula and is one of the most famous tourist destinations worldwide. The peninsula gets its name from the main town. Its stunning coastal views are hard to forget. The Sorrento peninsula extends from Castellamare di Stabia to the extreme tip of the promontory, Punta Campanella, a watershed between the Gulfs of Naples and Salerno, spectacularly overlooking the north coast of the Gulf of Naples. The Amalfi Coast is located on the southern side offering delightful villages, perched on rocky cliffs, suspended over the sea.

The Lattari Mountains form the geographical backbone of the peninsula. The island of Capri lies off the western tip of the peninsula in the Tyrrhenian. Sorrento's charm is mythical and ancient. There are many points of interest and historic landmarks, from the historic centre to its artistic tradition and splendid citrus groves. The ancient portal, Porta Greca, leads tourists to a place where time has stood still. Among the many places of interest to be visited, the Correale Museum is certainly not to be missed with its fine collection of minor arts from the 17th and 18th centuries, the inlaid wood museum, churches and the Cloister of St Francesco, oldest monument of Sorrento. Pompeii, Herculaneum, Naples, the Amalfi Coast, and the island of Capri are only a few of what you can see.



Travel program

DAY 1 – Naples to Sorrento

Pick up at the airport/train station or Hotel and transfer to 4 star hotel in Sorrento surrounding areas by private bus.

DAY 2 – Sorrento – Private Walking Tour Breakfast at the hotel.

Morning: Half-day morning, 2 hours (start at 9.00am) About this tour: Discover the beautiful town of Sorrento joining a dedicated walking tour of 2 hours with a local guide. Follow the guide through Tasso Square, admire the Sant'Antonino Church and the San Francesco Cloister, and marvel at the spectacularly ancient Valley of the Mills. Get a sense of local life as you stroll around the old fishing village of Marina Grande and enjoy the stunning view of the Neapolitan Riviera from breathtaking viewpoints.

In the little alleys of Sorrento, you could appreciate the local art craft such as the inlaid woodworks and the famous

Sorrento sandals.

DAY 3 - Capri - Full day, (start at 9am)

DESCRIPTION: Pick up at your hotel hall and embark for a daily tour of Capri island. Meeting with our private guide at Sorrento Port and departure with public hydrofoil to Capri. After departure with private taxi for a tour land at Capri and time at leisure to visit the queen of social life and luxury, a meeting point for politicians, jet-setters and movie stars. A stroll through its famous piazzetta is a must if you want to revel in the heart of this charming and mysterious place. Visit of Villa San Michele situated in Anacapri the second town of island famous thanks the writer Alexel Munthe. Free time for shopping. In the afternoon return to the hotel.

DAY 4 - Pompeii Visit with Wine Tasting Full day, 6 hours (start at 8.15am)

Breakfast at the hotel.

DESCRIPTION: Pick up by driver and Mercedes Vehicle and departure to Pompei excavation for two hours visit of the majestic town. Your private guide will meet you at the entrance with Skip the line tickets for a unique walking tour.

Pompeii is one of the most significant proofs of Roman civilization and, like an open book, provides outstanding information on the art, customs, trades and everyday life of the past. The city has re emerged from the darkness of centuries precisely as it would have been when it was unexpectedly buried in the thick layer of ash and lava which poured down from the devastating eruption of Vesuvius. It was the year 79 A.D. The scale of the tragedy was appalling: in what had been one of the most active and splendid Roman centers, life came to a permanent standstill.

The thick layer of volcanic material which submerged it, made up to a large extent of ash and lapilli - non-hard material, unlike that which covered Herculaneum and which solidified into extremely hard stone -has meant that the city has remained intact until the present day, not only as far as its buildings are concerned, but also as regards the contents inside the houses and shops, providing an absolutely fascinating picture of "daily" life.

After transfer to Cantina del Vesuvio Farm and visit of vineyards and its cellar with tasting of five differente type of wine and light lunch with salumi, bread, oil cheese, Spaghetti with tomato souce and neapolitan pastiera cake. At the end transfer to Sorrento.

DAY 7 - Excursion to Positano, Amalfi and Ravello Full day, 8 hours (Start at 9.00am)

Breakfast at the hotel.

DESCRIPTION: Breakfast in your hotel and pick up by Minivan and English speaking driver to explore the picturesque colors reflecting the enchanting landscape of Positano. This village is a true paradise, developed vertically within a tangled overlay of streets, alleys and shops that expose the colorful Positano fashions well-known all around the world. In the town center is the Parish Church of Santa Maria Assunta that shows up with its large dome, tiled in majolica and sheltering some precious works like polychrome marble altars. Continue the visit along the coast and enjoy amazing views on the blue of the sea, the green of the Mediterranean maquis and the hues of citrus fruits spreading out over terraced cultivations that blend with the typical architecture in order to create one of the most beautiful itineraries in Italy. You can also enjoy a panoramic view of Furore, located a few miles away, is an authentic open-air contemporary art gallery, with typical fresco-painted houses, public buildings and small piazzas. If you wish to discover the heart of this land, many naturalistic itineraries all for the exploring await you, with intense colors and perfumes of agave, Indian figs, mastic gum and rosemary.

Then visit Amalfi, the town whose name blesses the entire coast. Dominated by the majestic Cathedral dedicated to Sant'Andrea (St. Andrew), Amalfi proffers innumerable testimonies of its glorious past as a Maritime Republic.

Transfer to Ravello and visit of Famous Villa Rufolo and its beautiful gardens. At the end return to Sorrento.
